

**Amnion Pregnancy Center
Nurse Sonographer
Job Description**

Objectives of the Position:

The nurse sonographer plays a key role in providing medical services and education throughout the patient appointment, helping enable the patient to make a decision for life.

Reports To: Director of Services

Employee Status: Part-time (16-24 hours/week), Non-exempt

Qualifications:

1. Be a committed Christian who demonstrates a personal relationship with Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord.
2. Exhibit a strong commitment and dedication to the pro-life position and to sexual purity.
3. Agree with and be willing to uphold the Commitment of Care and Competence, Statement of Faith, and policies and procedures of Amnion.
4. Maintain a current Minnesota RN nursing license and CPR certification.
5. Have several years of clinical nursing experience; OB/GYN experience would be beneficial.
6. Demonstrate strong communication skills, courteous professionalism, and competent organizational skills.

Program Responsibilities:

1. Observe all Amnion's Medical Policies and Procedures.
2. Demonstrate an understanding of medical liability issues.
3. Adhere to the 15 Step Focus Process.
4. Take a basic health history, answer questions, and give information according to the nursing script.
5. Provide early, obstetric ultrasounds according to APC's protocol.
6. Work together with the advocate and other medical staff to determine, according to the patient process, what the next step for the patient will be.
7. Communicate with Director of Services about any unusual patient cases.
8. Assist with assigned day-to-day tasks, such as supply inventory and restocking of rooms, etc.
9. Maintain all pertinent medical documentation regarding patient's ultrasound.
10. Respond to medical clinic/MD requests for information as needed.

Other Responsibilities:

1. Attend monthly medical staff meetings.
2. Attend monthly all-staff meetings.
3. Assist at fund-raising events as requested.
